VACATION OVERVIEW

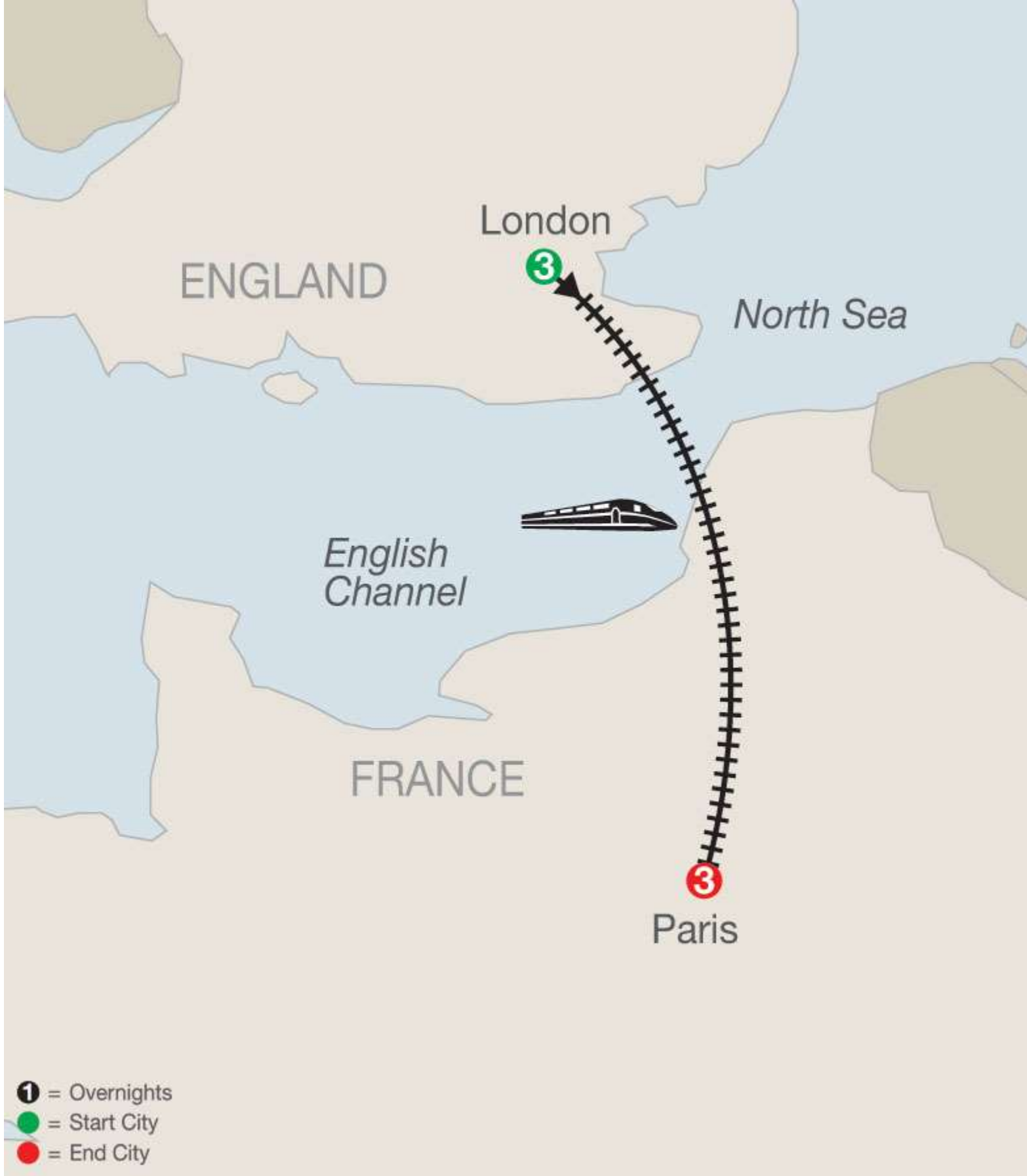

DAY 1 ARRIVE IN LONDON, ENGLAND
